

MIDDLE SCHOOL SKI CLUB RULES

- ◆ All school rules and regulations as outlined in your School's Student Handbook are in effect.
- ◆ Students **MUST** ride the SKI CLUB bus to and from the ski resort when participating in the ski program unless the parent transportation form has been completed **PRIOR** to departure. Violation may result in immediate removal from the club without refund.
- ◆ Students arriving late to their bus when boarding at the ski resort will lose their next week of skiing without refund.
- ◆ While at the ski area, students will not sit at tables where alcoholic beverages are present.
- ◆ Ski passes are not transferable.
- ◆ Club members are required to follow the Ohio Safety in Skiing Law:
 - Ski under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid other skiers or objects.
 - When skiing downhill or overtaking another skier, you must avoid the skier below you.
 - You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
 - When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to other skiers.
 - All skiers shall wear retention straps or other devices to prevent runaway skis.
 - You shall keep off closed trails and posted areas and observe all posted signs.
- ◆ Club members are to follow School, Ski club, and Ski Area Rules.
- ◆ Any student not picked up by 10:20p.m. will forfeit his/her right to ski the next week.
- ◆ The ski buses will leave school for the ski resort at 3:30p.m. Any student not on the bus and ready to go will be left behind.
- ◆ If school is canceled on a ski trip day, the ski trip is also canceled. **NO SCHOOL, NO SKIING!** You will be notified as to when the ski day will be made up.
- ◆ In case of an emergency (bus breakdown, weather, etc.) the advisor will have someone come to the school and inform the parents of the situation.
- ◆ The Once A Week Ski Program ID cards are issued each week for use by the students and are to be returned to the ski club chaperones at the end of session.
- ◆ Once paid monies are non-refundable.
