Please Read All Information

Dear Ski Club Parents:

The school sponsored Ski Club will be skiing at Mad River on Tuesday evenings beginning January 8, 2019. A minimum number of students from each school are required to enable us to send a bus to the ski area. If necessary sharing a bus with another Dublin middle school can accomplish this. If we don't have enough students to meet the bus requirements, we will have to cancel the bus.

The Ski Club payments are divided between your school and Mad River as follows:

The Mad River portion of the signup process is done online using the Mad River website and a credit card.

Username & Password are given when ski forms and money are turned in to the ski club advisor at your school.

The Middle School portion for joining the Ski Club is paid to your school. Dues cover Ski Club activities and riding the bus. **Ski Club dues are \$145.**

Checks payable to your school: **Davis Middle School or Grizzell Middle School or Karrer Middle School or Sells Middle School.**

Please put skiers name on the **check memo.**

Deadline to turn in forms is **Monday, November 19, 2018**

*****No Cash is accepted. ***Dues are non-refundable!**

Turn in and Information meeting at each school. The ski advisor will be in the commons area to answer questions, to notarize medical forms, and to accept forms.

Davis: Monday, October 15 from 6:00pm to 7:30PM

Sells: Monday, October 15 from 8:00pm to 9:00pm

Grizzell: Tuesday, October 16 from 7:30pm to 8:30pm

Karrer: Wednesday, October 17 from 7:30pm to 8:30pm

To Join Ski Club you need to:

1. Fill out the School Ski Club Application Form.
2. Fill out the Notarized Medical Authorization Form.
3. Write a check payable your skier's Middle School for \$145.
4. Turn in all these items to the Ski Club Advisor to get the username and password.

Ski Day Equipment Storage:

Davis: Equipment to be placed in the closet next to the stage in the commons area.

Grizzell: Equipment to be placed in Boys or Girls locker room.

Karrer: Equipment to be placed in the Choir Room storage closet.

Sells: Equipment to be placed in the Boiler Room on the first floor of the 1919 building.

Skiing/Boarding Information:

All skiers and boarders must have a photo ID picture taken by Mad River personnel.

Any Ski forms and/or money turned in after November 19, 2018 require a \$50 late fee.

No ski forms will be accepted after Jan. 8, 2019.

DATES: Mad River–**Tuesdays: January 8,15,22,29 February 5,12 Make Up: February 19,29, March 5,12** second trip in a given week may be necessary because of weather or uncontrolled circumstances.

Deadline for ONLINE PURCHASES for Mad River is Friday, December 14, 2018. After that only paper forms will be accepted.

No ski pass can be issued until Ski Club dues are paid and all forms turned in.

MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION FORM MUST BE NOTARIZED

NOTE: Due to weather or other circumstances beyond our control, a minimum number of trips and/or lessons are not guaranteed or implied. The program starts with one visit followed by up to five or more possible visits. If school is cancelled, Ski Club is cancelled. We will make it up at the end.

“ONCE A WEEK” SKI PASSES are issued to the students each week as they get off the buses and collected when they re-board the buses for the return trip. If a skier is not able to participate on a given day, the ski pass cannot be sold or given to another skier.

ALL PROGRAM PRIVILEGES are subject to revocation without a refund for violation of school, ski club, or ski area rules.

HELMETS: All skiers and Boarders should wear a helmet at all times on the ski slopes at the ski area. (See attached note titled “Helmet and Wrist Guard”)

WRIST GUARDS: All Snowboarders should purchase and wear guards at all times when on the slopes at the ski area. (See attached note titled “Helmets and Wrist Guards”)

SKI CHECK: Use this resource to prevent lost, stolen, or misplaced ski equipment. **(It happens)**
